RULES FOR JUDGING CLUB WINNERS

(The attached form will be used by each Club and the District in selecting a Club or the District winner)

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| 1-15 | Quality of Community Service Performed
Please judge the overall quality of the community service performed by the student, not the total number of hours of service performed. | 15 – Highest |
| 1- 15 | Non-required School and Community Service
Up to 5 points may be awarded for required community service unless such service is exceptional. If so, an additional 2 points may be awarded. Therefore, no more than 7 points may be assigned to <u>required</u> community service. Greater weight must always be given to community service the student is not required to perform, the initiative shown by the student, and the impact on the community impacted/targeted by the service, whether local and/ or global). | 15 – Highest |
| 1-15 | Description of one or two Community Service Projects performed by the student and the Impact the student believes the service has had on the student's community and on the targeted community, if different. | 15 – Highest |
| 1-5 | Principal, Guidance Counselor, or Not-for-Profit Leader/Supervisor's Letter | 5 – Highest |

The number of points allotted to each category reflects the importance of the information. Academic achievement is not to be considered in scoring an application.
