Zonta International is a leading global organization of individuals working together to build a better world for women and girls.

WHO CAN JOIN?

Although Zonta started as an organization of professional women, many clubs - including ours - have members of all genders from a wide-variety of professional backgrounds.

Members must be 18+, be sponsored by a current member, and pledge to uphold the values of Zonta.

Dues are \$82-135/year, and payment plans are available.

MEETINGS

The full club meets once a month from September to June - usually on the 3rd Wednesday of the month for a business or program meeting.

Business Meetings: Club business and governance **Program Meetings:** Education on women's issues, leadership development, and/or hands on activities **Committee Meetings:** Support club advocacy, education, and service goals and are a great way to stay active and build relationships with other members.

Business and Program meetings begin with fellowship and last approximately 2 hours. There is no cost to attend meetings, and members are encouraged to bring guests to program and committee meetings.
